SEVENFOLD POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

1. **ARCH** - divine power that can create something out of nothing. It is that power that brings forth something from itself as the source of beginning.

Example- Electrical arc that is the point of ignition for man's machinery gives us an accurate picture of this divine creative power of the Holy Spirit.

- **In Creation** - John 1:1, 3; Gen. 1:2-3; Heb. 11:3; Heb. 1:10
- **The Incarnation** – Luke 1:35; Matt. 1:18-20; Isa. 7:14; Luke 1:35; Heb. 10:5; John 1:14
- **New Creation** - 1 John 2:24; **1 Pet. 1:23; 2 Cor. 5:17; Col. 1:27**

2. **EXOUSIA** - Greek word translated into English as power, particularly denotes the ability to decide and preform an action without hindrance. Exousia is the decisive authority of God. This word is usually used with **arche**, the power that sparks **exousia**.

Example- Exousia reflects the power and the right to influence and enforce, the kind of right that government officials exercise. It depicts authority as well as divine ability to perform a task.

- Mark 2:9-10
- Power that enables us to become sons and daughters of the King. (John 1:12)
- Power used to convict, reprove, refute, or convince. (John 16:8; 1 Cor. 12:3)

3. **ISCHUS** - expresses the boisterous, valiant, almighty force of divine power with its ability to penetrate opposition.

Example- Military force demonstrates this kind of power. We could call this the “bulldozer breath” of God.

- Preached word of God (Acts 19:20) *“In this way the word of the Lord spread widely and grew in power.”*
 - (1 John 2:14b; Eph. 6:10) The meaning of power in this text is divine strength to conquer supernatural foes.
- 4. **DIDOMI-** the root meaning of the Greek word *didomi* translates as “**the power to give.**” This didomi power reveals the realistic character of love as a gift, not just a disposition. This is the power of **action**, not just a feeling, in love. (Ex. John 6:37; John 6:68; John 17:7)
- 5. **ENERGIA-** power that means a *divine energizing force that works effectually and powerfully.* (Ex. James 1:21b; Heb. 4:12; Phil. 2:13; Acts 2:40)
- 6. **KRATOS-** the superior power of God, to which the final victory belongs. (Ex. 1 Pet. 5:11; Col. 1:11; Jude 1:25; Rev. 5:13)
- 7. **MAGALEIOTES-** magnificence and majesty of God as seen in the transfiguration of Christ. (Ex. 2 Pet. 1:16-18; Luke 9:43a; Eph. 2:6)
